

Nationwide Express: Establish Billing Plan & Finalize Quote



Establish Billing Plan

Step 1

Action	Screen
<p>The “Billing” subtab has you establishing the billing plan that works best for your customer. This will not collect the payment. It’s simply acknowledging the preferred method. The billing preferences can also be edited before binding.</p> <p>a. Notice on this example you see the mortgagee information displayed at the top since the homeowner policy is in escrow.</p> <p>b. If there is a discount associated with a particular pay plan, it will be indicated in blue as you see on the screen for “Recurring EFT” and “Pay in full”.</p> <p>c. Notice details around which payment plan may be better for the customer depending on telematics preferences.</p> <p>d. The “Finalize quote” button is unlocked.</p>	

Finalize Quote

Step 1

Action	Screen
<p>You may receive messages where Nationwide did not return a quote for both auto and homeowner. Thus, there is no underwriting approval; quote with another carrier.</p>






Step 2



Action	Screen
<p>The message “Additional documentation is required prior to finalizing the quote” ask you to navigate to get pre-quote underwriting approval.</p> <p>Select “Help” to get the submission ID for each product. You will need them to submit your approval</p>	
	

Step 3


Action	Screen
a. You are now on to the initial quote, whether this is where you initially landed or after your quote is approved from Underwriting. This is not a bindable rate. Depending on your state, the rates will populate once you get underwriting approval.	
b. You must complete rating tasks to move forward.	
c. You can also perform several actions from this page including refreshing reports, changing telematics enrollments, reviewing discounts and surcharges and making further adjustments to coverages.	
d. Note that navigation is open on the left. You can go anywhere you need to if changes are required.	
e. Also on the left navigation there is a tab labeled "Account information".	

Finalize Quote (cont'd)


Step 4

Action	Screen
<p>When you select the “Account information” tab, it will open up an additional window to update producer info as needed. Simply select the  icon.</p> <p>Once you make the necessary updates, select the “Save and continue” button</p>	

Step 5

Action	Screen
<p>If you don't already have it quoted, you can add a PUL on this screen. Nationwide Express automatically adjusts the underlying limits as needed.</p> <p>Again, in the tabs below “Review policies”, you can easily navigate to edit coverages or discounts, add or remove telematics, and review or order reports.</p> <p><u>If you opt to go to PolicyCenter for any reason, close the Nationwide Express quote to avoid any issues with the quote.</u> Communication is two-way, and it gets garbled if both platforms are open while you're making changes.</p> <p>You can change the pay plan here, but you'll need to requote because of discounts.</p> <p>If the customer is ready to proceed, select the “Start rating tasks” button.</p>	

Step 6

Action	Screen
<p>Rating tasks will advise of what is missing or needed to proceed.</p> <p>Online account registration is what most often populates. Select the “Confirm Registration” button.</p>	

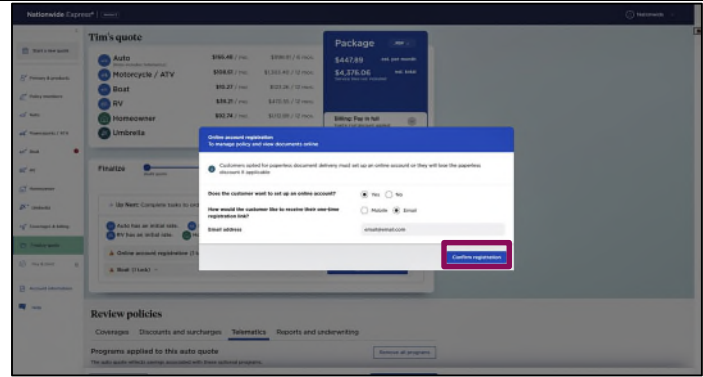
Finalize Quote (cont'd)

Action

Answer the “Online account registration” questions and select the “Update registration” button.
