

Grandfathered Coverage Limits



This job aid explains grandfathered coverage limits.

Step 1

Action

When processing a change to a grandfathered coverage limit, the initial grandfathered coverage limit will remain in the drop-down menu until the change is issued.

For example, if a user changes the grandfathered coverage of \$0 to non-grandfathered coverage of \$250, PolicyCenter will allow the \$0 limit to be selected until the change is issued. The user could select the grandfathered coverage limit of \$0 within the transaction without having to withdraw the change.

You can still make a change to the coverage limits as desired.

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
