

What is the Virtual Training Office?

The Virtual Training Office (VTO) is a training environment that looks like PolicyCenter (PC). The VTO is meant to provide a place to learn the navigation inside of PolicyCenter and to become comfortable with the look and feel of PolicyCenter. The major difference is the training environment is it is set up for the state of *Indiana only* and not linked to any downstream systems, such as VIN service, Rating, or Document services. This means some connections are "virtualized". This virtualization does have some quirks we want you to be aware of before using the training environment. They are listed in the Q&A section, on pages 2 through 5, of this document. While the VTO virtualizes some connections, other connections to downstream systems (for example, AGCM), are not virtualized.

How do I use the Virtual Training Office?

We have set up quick cards for you to use to assist in your VTO experience. These are step-by-step instructions to help you simulate scenarios you may use in your daily job. These instructions are set up, with the aforementioned quirks in mind, to obtain the desired results.

This guide provides you the basic steps for locating all Virtual Training Office training resources and includes direction on how to access the VTO.

- 1. Open the VTO training environment.
 - Use the following URL: https://personallinespls82.nationwide.com/pc/PolicyCenter.do
- *Copy this link and paste it in a new internet window or tab.
- 2. Select a **User Name** from the list*. A **Password** is <u>required</u>. The password for all users is 'gw' (lowercase).

Note: After 3 failed attempts to login, the User will be locked. You will need to email PCLearn@nationwide.com to unlock the user.

^{*}Note: There are a total of 90 generic Agent User IDs. All User IDs follow the logic above - agent50, agent59, agent89, etc. In a few quick cards, you are instructed to use a specific user name.

- 3. Access the list of VTO Quick Cards on the <u>Personal Lines PolicyCenter/One Product Site</u>, and select a quick card to use in the VTO.
 - Each quick card provides step-by-step instructions for various PolicyCenter tasks.
 - Quick cards have been written for the most common activities performed in PolicyCenter and organized by course.

	*Note: There is no real data in the VTO. Real data should not be entered in the VTO. The VTO is only virtualized for the state of Indiana.		
What are the general differences	The VTO is set up for the state of Indiana only.		
between the VTO training environment and the PolicyCenter live environment?	You <u>must</u> have a Social Security Number for all persons listed on a policy to get valid results in the VTO. SSN is not a required field in the live environment.		
	We have virtualized the rating response. The rate you receive in the VTO <u>will not</u> be the same in production. The VTO is virtualized for the state of Indiana only.		
	The License Number field is required and validated. You <u>must</u> use a license number from the VTO Quick Card or from the Driver's License Number section of this document.		
	Earthquake coverage is available to add to a new submission. In the VTO, if Earthquake coverage is added to a new submission, it will only return an Eligible result.		
	When a submission is in "Quoted" status, you can click the Print Quote button to view and print the quote. A PDF opens; all documents will display with Kelly Test as the primary named insured.		
	To receive a rate for an Umbrella submission, you <u>must</u> select the checkbox to the left of Uninsured Motorist / Underinsured Motorist option. If you don't, you will receive the message, "We were unable to rate this policy at this time due to a system outage. Please try again later".		
	On the <i>Policy Info</i> screen, do not select " Yes " as the Easy Pay Sign Up option. Select " No ". If " Yes " is selected, an error will occur for billing on the <i>Payment</i> screen.		
	We have virtualized Billing within the VTO. You <u>must</u> select the Direct Billed option in the <i>Installment Plan</i> section. In the <i>Down Payment Details</i> section, select Cash, Check or Money Order for down payment type.		



	The new Automatic Delivery of Required Documents eSign feature is now available in the VTO.
	eSignature is completed on the <i>Documents</i> screen.
	Select the documents you would like to include the envelope. On the eSign Details screen, you can enter any email address and add a Carbon Copy if desired. AnThe eSignature envelope will only display the "Sent" status.
	Note : An email will <u>not</u> be sent from the VTO.
	In the live environment, you can click the Add button to add additional documents in PolicyCenter to the eSignature envelope prior to sending the envelope. In the VTO, the Add functionality will produce the following error "The following documents are not available: [Fair Credit Reporting Act - Post Notification, Cover Letter, Privacy Statement] If using eSignature, you must remove the document(s) before sending the envelope."
	After the eSignature envelope has been sent, you can click the Void button and send a new envelope.
	Note : In the live environment, you can click the View button to view/print/save the document; however, this functionality is not available in the VTO.
	Please refer to the <i>Full Application Quick Cards</i> to demonstrate the eSignature functionality in the VTO.
	The deep launch to DocVault from PolicyCenter is not available in the VTO. The link in the <i>Tools</i> section of the Left Navigation Pane is not functionable in the VTO.
	On Policy Change, Renewal, and Rewrite Work Orders, the Billing Calculator button will display. This functionality is not available in the VTO.
	You will notice Testing and Training tabs at the top of the PC screen in the VTO. These tabs <u>will not</u> be present in the live environment.
Cloning	Cloning allows you to take the policy exactly as is and create a copy, including any changes. You will be able to clone policies from the Training tab. Clones allow you to experience certain situations, such as Preemption and Out-of-Sequence, without extensive setup. This functionality will not be available in the live environment.

How do I run reports and other	VIN Services - 30 VINs have been virtualized for Auto.
external calls in the VTO?	Using one of the virtualized VINs, you will retrieve actual VIN information. If you select a VIN other than one listed in the VINs section below, you will get a 2014 Honda Civic, regardless of the vehicle to which the VIN actually corresponds.
	Current Carrier results will be the same for all entries, regardless what name is used to create a new submission. It is recommended to not to enter this information on the Prior Policies tab, but to allow the Virtual Service to return the data.
	ALH results are tied to specific VINs and results are based on the first vehicle.
	For example, you will get a different result if you enter VIN A as Vehicle 1 and VIN B as Vehicle 2, compared to VIN A as Vehicle 2 and VIN B as Vehicle 1.
	In the VTO, the driver information is not considered when retrieving ALH results.
	MVR will only return clean results in the VTO for new submissions with one driver. No results for the additional drivers will be returned.
	MSB values will be the same for every new submission.
	A new browser window will launch MSB as it does in the live environment. However, it is not an active link. In the VTO, you will click the OK button to close the window. In the live environment, you will handle MSB as you do today.
	Note: On some policies you may need to click the Launch MSB button twice to trigger the service.
	PLH results are tied to a specific date of birth. If you enter the date of birth of 8/18/58, you will get property losses returned. For any other date of birth entered, you will retrieve clean property loss history report. In the VTO, the property address is not considered when retrieving PLH results.
	VIN, HIN, and Serial Numbers for PowerSports policies.
	VIN services return for Motorcycle and Off-Road. HIN and Serial Numbers do not have a service like VIN, but are required to bind RV and Boat policies.
Can I print documents from the VTO?	Print Quote will open in a PDF as it does in PolicyCenter. No other documents are available to print.
What downstream systems are not linked in the VTO?	AGSS, AGCM, and the Nonstandard quoting system are not linked to the VTO.

How long will my scenarios/policies stay in the VTO?	The VTO is refreshed weekly on Friday at 9 pm EST. Any scenarios/policies entered during the week will be removed during that refresh.	
I tried to add a mortgage (Third Party lienholder) on a Property policy but I keep getting an error. Search Third Party * Your search resulted in too many records results returned, please refine your search.	The VTO will only support 20 of the same record. If there are more than 20 records for the bank you searched, with the same address, you will see this error. If you run into this issue, you can create a third party record with any unique bank.	
Can I release multiple Policy Transactions on the same day in the VTO?	There are no limitations to how many Policy Transactions (changes) you can make in a day on a policy or new submission.	
Will my producer code be defaulted in PolicyCenter?	When in the VTO and acting as a generic user, you may need to select a producer code when creating a new account or submission. In the live environment, producer codes will default.	
May I use the Back and Forward buttons on my web browser?	No. The Back and Forward buttons on the web browser are NOT supported in the PolicyCenter live environment, nor in the VTO.	
What is the preferred browser for PolicyCenter?	With the upgrade to version 10 and later versions of PolicyCenter, the preferred browser is Chrome. Other modern browsers, such as Edge and Firefox, will also provide the optimal experience. Internet Explorer (IE).
